**APPROVING THE INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE TOWN OF GATES AND THE
COUNTY OF MONROE FOR SNOW AND ICE
SERVICES**

RESOLUTION 123-18: Motion by Councilman Cordero who moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Town of Gates and the County of Monroe have previously entered into Intermunicipal Agreements for Snow and Ice Control Services to be furnished by the Town of Gates to the County of Monroe; and

WHEREAS, such Intermunicipal Agreements are periodically renewed; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Gates has received a current Snow and Ice Control Services Agreement covering the period October 1, 2018 to and through September 30,,2019 with annual renewals upon mutual consent for a period of up to four additional years; and

WHEREAS, SUCH PROPOSED Intermunicipal Agreement has been reviewed by Kurt Rappazzo, Director of Public Works and Mark Assini, Supervisor, and it has been found to be acceptable;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Board of the Town of Gates, Monroe County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. That the Supervisor, be and he hereby is, authorized to enter into an Intermunicipal Agreement by and between the Town of Gates and the County of Monroe for Snow and Ice Control Services, covering the period of October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019 with annual renewals upon mutual consent for a period of up to four additional years.
